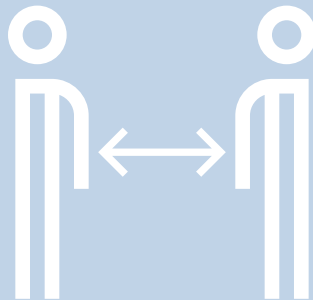
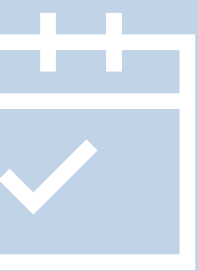

Bologna Convention Bureau is a business unit within Bologna Welcome created with the aim of promoting the destination as the perfect location for congresses and events, and represents a **network of over 80 operators within the Metropolitan City of Bologna**, including **venues** of different types, **PCOs and event organization agencies, as well as companies supplying collateral services.**

For those who wish to organize an event of any kind and accommodation capacity, **Bologna Convention Bureau and its staff are at your complete disposal** for any information and will support you in your choice among the manifold new possibilities of the destination free of charge.

Venues

All available locations in the Metropolitan City of Bologna have undergone a rearrangement process of their spaces in compliance with the regional Guidelines for congresses, conventions and similar events; the maximum number of participants for every event will be assessed according to the capacity of the spaces in order to reduce crowding and ensure the required social distance.

The spaces' sanitation and reorganization allow for an orderly access as to avoid gatherings of people ensuring the maintenance of at least one meter of distance between people; the venues are thus ready to host events in total safety.

PCO and Event organization agencies

The Professional Congress Organizers and Event Organization Agencies of the Metropolitan City of Bologna commit to guiding and supporting the event promoters to facilitate their organization, offering secretarial services and coordinating all collateral services in new ways and in full compliance with the current regulations.

Services

The event and service providing suppliers have remodeled their offer range with brand new services in compliance with the regulation in force, such as:

- highly trained personnel services
- increasingly performing digital technologies to allow for the realization of even hybrid events
- catering services for the administration of food according to current standards
- installations respecting the minimum space standards

Palazzo Boncompagni

Overview

Palazzo Boncompagni is located in the historic center, a few hundred meters from Piazza Maggiore and the Two Towers. The Palace, where Pope Gregory XIII was born, is characterized by its sober facade and large decorated portal. The completion and the ornaments of the Palace are attributed to Jacopo Barozzi while the splendid helical staircase and the end of the loggia with the entrance portal to the staircase are attributed to Vignola.

Inside, the extraordinary 'Pope's Room' opens up, adorned with a sandstone fireplace, probably made to a design by Pellegrino Tibaldi.

Post Covid Emergency

All the rooms and contact surfaces of Palazzo Boncompagni are carefully cleaned and sanitized before and after every event or visit.

The service staff is trained on all protective procedures and is equipped with personal protective equipment during work, such as disinfectants, face covering devices and disposable gloves.

For guided tours, staggered accesses are organized and access is allowed in small groups (max 15 people) ensuring the spacing and providing participants, in case they are not equipped, with disposable face covering devices and gloves. For events, the seats are positioned in such a way as to ensure social distance and the entrance to the room is managed by the staff to avoid crowds. They are placed in multiple hand disinfectant zones.

In the toilets, disinfection is carried out several times a day and liquid soap and disposable wipes are available.
