Overview

Manzoni Auditorium was born as a cinema and theater in Bologna in 1933. An Art Nouveau building built in the historic center just a stone's throw from Piazza Maggiore. Its pure art nouveau style, represented by the external facades and the internal decorations and frescoes, is naturally maintained and respected in the radical restoration that took place in 2003. The theater thus becomes a prestigious Auditorium accessible 12 months a year, thanks to the complete air conditioning summer / winter. The Manzoni Auditorium represents an excellent setting for various kinds of events.

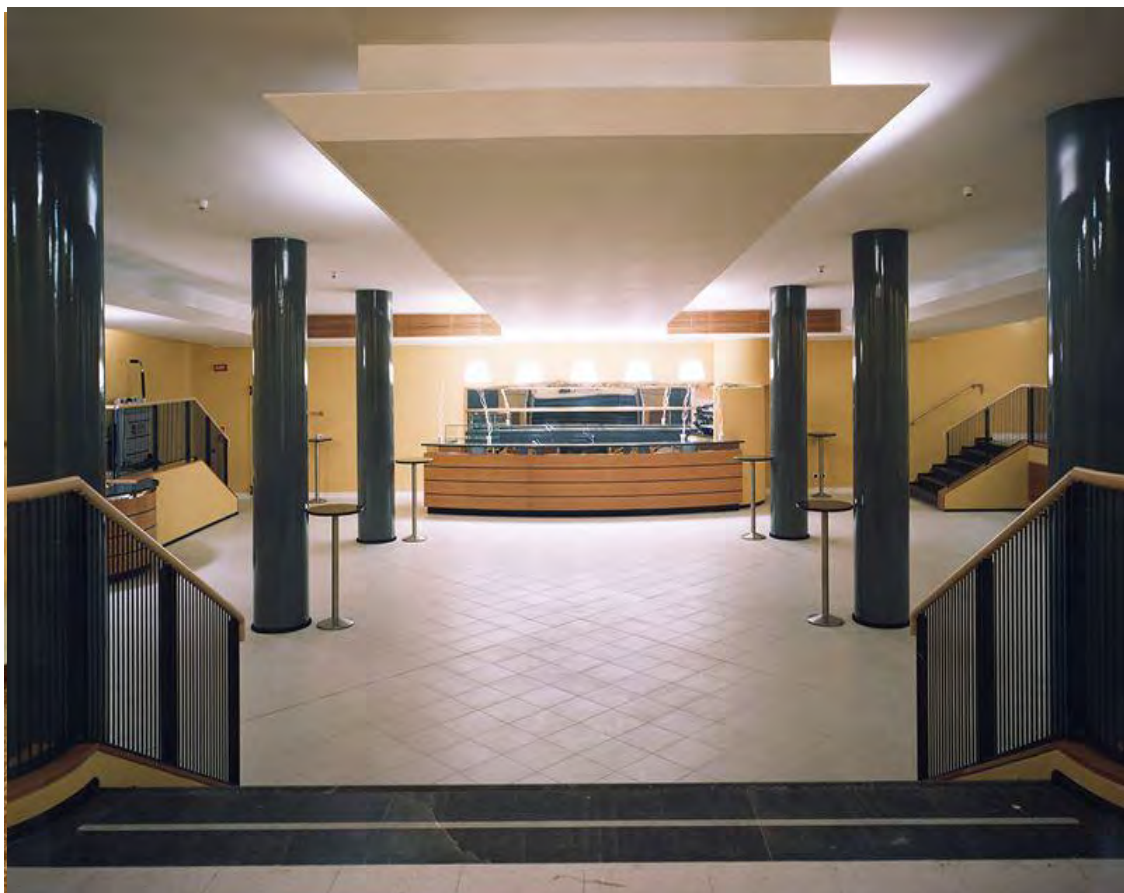
