



# Fondazione Collegio Artistico Venturoli

---

## Overview

The Fondazione Collegio Venturoli was established in 1826 through a bequest by Bolognese architect Angelo Venturoli (1749–1821), as a place for training young talents in the visual arts and architecture. It still fulfills this mission by awarding artists' studios through a competitive selection.

Housed in a frescoed late 17th-century palace in Bologna's historic center, it preserves the founder's archive, art collections, a plaster cast gallery, and a 19th-century painting gallery, open by appointment. Its spaces, including a garden, host cultural activities, exhibitions, events, and ceremonies in the consecrated private chapel.
