Overview

Opened in 2025 in the historic Parco della Montagnola, Filla is a multifunctional civic space designed by architect Mario Cucinella. Bright and highly energy-efficient, the building serves as a hub dedicated to sustainability and the ecological transition.

The glass-and-steel structure echoes the city's iconic porticoes and features a spacious Auditorium, a Laboratory area, and a family-friendly Café. Thanks to its historical and scenic setting, Filla provides an ideal backdrop for events hosted by companies, associations, and private clients.
