

Fondazione Cirulli

Overview

The headquarters of the Cirulli Foundation is in San Lazzaro di Savena, a few kilometers from Bologna in a building that is a symbol of modern Italian architecture. Designed in 1960 by architects and designers Achille and Pier Giacomo Castiglioni for Dino Gavina, it is a place strongly linked to the history of Italian design. In addition to the large covered entrance, the building is spread over three levels: the 60 square meter foyer can accommodate about 60 standing people; the ground floor of 260 square meters can accommodate up to 50 people seated; the mezzanine floor of 150 square meters can accommodate up to 20 seated people; the first floor of 500 square meters - can accommodate up to 250 seated people. It is possible to combine the event with guided tours.
