



Palazzo Boncompagni

Overview

Palazzo Boncompagni is located in the historic center, just a short walk from Piazza Maggiore and the Two Towers. Once the residence of Pope Gregory XIII, it stands out for its 16th-century façade and large decorated portal.

The original core is attributed to Baldassarre Tommaso Peruzzi, while the completion and interior and exterior decorations are often linked to Jacopo Barozzi, known as Vignola, whose most famous feature is the spiral staircase. Inside, the 'Sala del Papa' houses a stone fireplace likely designed by Pellegrino Tibaldi.
